The aim of this is to provide as much as possible an English translation of the dedication and hard work that Homer as done in providing as far as possible a complete version of Alizée showbiz life up to the present day.

Alizée Chronology Version 3 Dated 8th March 2007

- 1 Alizée birth date 21st August 1984 in Ajaccio Corsica
- 2 1988: She begins to have dance classes
- 3 1995: she wins a drawing competition, the completed design is put on an aeroplane, and the plane is called Alizée.
- 4 **2000**: Alizée auditions for "Graines de star". First in Corsica (in the césar palace) and then in Paris interpreting the song "waiting for tonight". Although for several reasons the precise date of this is not clear for example it appears in some videos that it is actually 19th December 1999. Whilst when Graines de Star was broadcasted, a fragment of the video appears with the label: Audition January 2000.
- 5 **25**th **February 2000**: Alizée on "Graines de Star" performs "Ma Prière" which was originally sung by Axelle Red. In which Alizée comes first (source <u>Nidalizée</u>) However another source states it is the 26th of January (<u>gourmand'alizée</u>).
- 6 14th April 2000: She returns again on "Graines de Star", performing once again "Ma Prière" and this time Alizée also sings "Oh Happy Days" alongside three others; Marie and Sydney aged 13 and Claire 16. Claire won, whilst Alizée 15 at the time came second. (source Nidalizée). Claimed on another site it was 27th of February (gourmand'alizée). There is some doubt about the exact dates of "Graines De Star" performances by Alizée due to schedule changes on the show. Some videos show Alizée performances as dated in 1999, however Homer feels the above dates are correct.
- 7 **Spring 2000**: L. Boutonnant and P. Soloman do the photo session that will be the official promotional photo's for Moi...Lolita.
- 8 21st May 2000: Moi... Lolita begins to be aired on the radio
- 9 4th July 2000: Moi... Lolita single is released (source Nidalizée)
- 10 **26th July 2000**: The video of the song Moi...Lolita was released for the first time exclusively on the M6 network (source <u>actualizée</u> not to be confused with the magazine of the same name) (Some websites claim that the actual date is the 28th July 2000)
- 11 6th September 2000: Recorded appearance on Hit Machine that will be shown on the 16th.
- 12 8th September 2000: A news article and interview with Alizée in Ajaccio is broadcasted on the program "Le Grand Soir" with Jean-Pierre Foucault. Alizée's conduct throughout is mysterious, a trait that has continued until the present. She also performs Moi...Lolita and this is the first time since "Graines De Star" that she has appeared on TV. (Sources un brin d'Alizée, Nidalizée& tinkalizée)
- 13 **16**th **September 2000**: She appeared on "Hit Machine" on channel M6. On this occasion she appears dressed much more simplistic than she did in "Le Grand Soir." (Source Nidalizée & tinkalizée) She demonstrates the great fluent dancer that she is. In the evening of the same day at 18:15 hours she appears on studio 22 on RTL channel. In the interview Alizée gave, she stated that she is the one who chooses the subjects of her songs, and that the songs are about her life experiences. It is then Mylène Farmer who interprets these experiences and turns them into songs. It is for this reason that "Goumandises" is an autobiographical album. There is no video of this interview, nor is

- there much information about the interview, but it is commentated on <u>Alizée Web</u> in the news section and the section regarding television appearances. In addition there are photos of it and an audio recording.
- 14 23rd September 2000: Appeared on "Fan De" on channel M6 at 12:05 hours. (Source tinkalizée) This is the famous interview with Alizée on the boat. There is some confusion over the date of this video because there are several dates. There is the 23rd of September and there is February 2001 (or June of the same year but these are no more then repetitions (Source tinkalizée)). However there are several reasons why the correct date must be September 2000. Firstly her hairstyle is short in the video and matches the style she had in September. Secondly the logos of the programs are different. In the September transmission, the logo is an orange star in the bottom left of the screen with "Fan de" on it. In the 2001 version underneath "fan de", the words "best of" appears and this is a definite sign that it is just a repeat of the original interview.
- **29**th **September 2000**: Appeared on "Graines De Stars" on channel M6 at 20:50 hours (Source nidalizée & tinkalizée)
- **30**th **September 2000**: Appeared on "Dansez Maintenent" on France 2 (source <u>nidalizée</u> & <u>tinkalizée</u>). On the same day, an interview in "Megamix club" is broadcasted on the Belgium channel RTL (Source <u>tinkalizée</u>). There are many megamix appearances, however this one promotes Moi…Lolita, whereas the others (27th December 2000 and 1st of January and 23rd of May 2001) promote L'Alizé.
- 17 4th October 2000: 500,000 copies of Alizée debut single "Moi…Lolita" are sold in France, and it has occupied a high position in the singles charts for the three months since its release.
- **7**th **October 2000**: Alizée appears on "Tapis Rouge" on channel France 2 at 20:50 hours. (Source nidalizée & tinkalizée)
- **15th October 2000**: It is known that Alizée debut album will be called "Gourmandises", although the release date of it is not known. Similar circumstances to what happened with her second album "Mes courants électriques". As well as what is currently happening with her 3rd Album.
- **22nd October 2000**: Appeared on "Vivement Dimanche" at 13:35 hours. (Source nidalizée, Alizée Web & tinkalizée)
- **23rd October 2000**: Alizée second single "L'Alizé" is played for the first time on the radio.
- **28th October 2000**: Single, "Moi...Lolita" reaches a million sales. Appears on "Hit Machine". (Source tinkalizée)
- 23 6th November 2000: Alizée appears on the front cover of French magazine "Tele star". An interview with her is also published in the magazine. The interview raises the possibility of a concert but that will not happen until 26th August 2003.
- 24 7th November 2000: "Moi...Lolita" single is released in Turkey, Holland, and Germany
- **17**th **November 2000**: Alizée receives her first big award as the "révélation Française de l'annee" (French revelation of the year) at the M6 awards. A tearful and very emotional Alizée gives a speech full of gratitude bathed in tears. Very touching (source <u>Journalizée Nidalizée</u>, and tinkalizée).
- **20**th November 2000: a mini news article about Alizée is shown on the programme "Célébritiés" on channel TF1 at 22:40 hours (Source <u>tinkalizée</u>). This was commentated on <u>Alizée Web</u>.

- **24**th **November 2000**: A photo session by Phillipe Bouley for the promotion of L'Alizé. These photos are very known on the Internet and will be used in many magazines during the following months and even years.
- **28th November 2000**: Alizée debut album, "Gourmandises" is released. Coinciding with the release of the album is the release of her second single "L'Alizé".
- **2nd December 2000**: Alizée appears on "Hit machine" on the M6 channel, performing L'Alizé. (Source <u>nidalizée</u> & <u>tinkalizée</u>). This was reshown on 7th July 2001.
- **3rd December 2000**: Alizée performs on "Taipis Rouge" on channel France2 at 13:35 hours. It is also said that she appeared on "Vivement Demanche" performing L'Alizé. (Source nidalizée & tinkalizée).
- 31 6th December 2000: According to the website <u>Actualizée</u> (not to be confused with the magazine of the same name), the video for L'Alizé, was shown for the first time. It was shown on "morning Live" on the M6 network at 07.00 hours
- 32 9th December 2000: Alizée Performs on "telethon" on channel France2 and sings "L'Alizé". (Source Nidalizée & tinkalizée).
- 33 12th December 2000: The Maxi CD and the Vinyl version of "L'Alizé" are released.
- **16**th **December 2000**: Performance of "L'Alizé" on "Les Petite Princes on TF1 at 20:50 hours. Where she receives the nomination for "Petit prince de la milleure chanteuse (best female singer). (Source Journalizée, nidalizée, Nidalizée and tinkalizée).
- **24**th **December 2000**: Alizée first two singles are in the top three of the singles chart. "L'Alizé" occupies the number one spot, whilst "Moi…Lolita" is number three. This occurs for three weeks and has never happened in French music.
- **25**th **December 2000**: Alizée sings "L'Alizé" on "Les Anges d'un Soir (or petite Anges de Nöel") on Channel France2 at 23:05 hours. Alizée receives a trophy, the Trophée Des Anges presented to her by the child shown in the relevant picture on Homers website. (Source Un Brin d'Alizée, Journalizée, nidalizée, Nidalizée and tinkalizée).
- **26th December 2000**: News article about Alizée on "Stars de L'an 2000". (Source <u>tinkalizée</u>)
- **27**th **December 2000**: Appearance on the "Megamix Club" on channel RTL. (Source tinkalizée) There are two more dates where she appears on this programme, 1st of January 2001 and 23rd May 2001 and it is still necessary to confirm whether these are new appearance or repeats of her 27th December appearance.
- **28**th **December 2000**: Alizée sings "L'Alizé" on "Le Grand Hit" on M6 channel. (Source <u>nidalizée</u> & <u>tinkalizée</u>).
- **1**st **January 2001**: Appearance on "Megamix Club" on channel RTL. Source tinkalizée). See also 27th of December.
- **13**th **January 2001**: Alizée sings "L'Alizé" in the programme "Special Vidéo Gag" on the TF1 channel at 20:50 hours. (Source <u>nidalizée</u> and <u>tinkalizée</u>). She also sings "L'Alizé" on "Dansez maintenent" on France2 at 20:50 hours. In some parts, the performance on "Dansez Mantainent" appears to be from 13th February. But news on <u>Alizee world</u> disproves this and furthermore two days later pictures of the performance are published. <u>Nidalizée</u> and <u>tinkalizée</u> also have it as this date.
- **20**th **January 2001**: More music awards. This time it is in the NRJ music awards from the Cannes Ceremony, the awards are relayed directly onto TF1. Alizée wins two awards; one similar to the French revelation award she won at the M6 awards on the 17th November 2000 and the second award is for best web site. Alizée at the show also sings

- "L'Alizé".(Sources Journalizée no18 Journalizée no20, nidalizée, nidalizée and tinkalizée)
- **27**th **January 2001**: Broadcasted news report "Alizée, Clone of Myléné" on "Plus vite que la Musique" on M6. (Source <u>tinkalizée</u>)
- **29**th **January 2001**: Alizée appears in the concert of Restos du Coeur, "Les Enfoirés" in the Halle Tony Garnier in Lyon. The show will not be broadcasted until 9th March 2001 and chiefly on TF1.
- **12**th **February 2001**: Alizée's album "Gourmandises" reaches number one in the Album chart, three months after its release and reaches Platinum status this week having sold more than 300,000 copies. "L'Alizé" which was released in the same week supasses this and sells 500,000 copies. Her debut single "Moi...Lolita" however has sold 1.2 million copies in France alone.
- **17**th **February 2001**: The Vitoria de la Música credit "Gourmandises" with being the revelation of the year. However she did not win the award. Instead Henri Salvador won the award. (Sources Un Brin d'Alizée, Journalizée no 20 and nidalizée)
- **3rd March 2001**: She is interviewed on FunTV. (Source <u>tinkalizée</u>) The interview speaks of her journey from "Grains de stars" to "Les Enfoirés". It is broadcasted in its entirety on 3rd March at 16:00 hours, and Sunday 4th March at 14:30 hours, and again on the 7th march at 18:00 hours. The correct date for this interview is 3rd March 2001 and not 2nd May as it appears in several videos. In all websites the three showings are the 3rd, 4th and 7th of March and there is no suggestion of it being 2nd of May. Homer has no idea from where the error has arisen.
- **9th March 2001**: The "Les Enfoirés" concert is broadcasted (recorded 29th January) on TF1 at 20:50 hours. Alizée sings an adaptation of the sing by Laurent Voulzy "Rockollection". It was intended to be broadcasted on the 3rd of March, but it got postponed until the 9th of March. (source Journalizée no18 and tinkalizée)
- **20th March 2001**: "Moi…Lolita" goes on sale in Netherlands and enters at 6th position in the charts. (Source Journalizée no20)
- **21**st **March 2001**: Photo Sessions for the Promotion of "Parler tout bas" by Phillipe Bouley. (Source: Alizee newspaper, which stated that there were sessions on the 19th, 20th and 21st, with another on the 22nd in Ajaccio. Tinkalizée disputes this, but Homer prefers to believe the newspaper).
- **28th March 2001**: Wardrobe test in Paris for the clothes used in "Parler tout bas" (Source Diary of Alizée).
- **31**st March 2001: Alizée sings "Parler tout bas" on the Programme "Tapis Rouge" hosted by Michel Drucker (Source Journalizée no18 and Nidalizée)
- **3 or 4th March**: Shooting of "Parler tout bas" in Paris. (Source Dairy of Alizee) Here Jean Marie has a photo session
- **21**st **April 2001**: She appears on "hit machine" performing "Parler tout bas" (Source: nidalizée & tinkalizée)
- **24th April 2001**: Alizée third single "Parler tout bas" is released. (Lov'alizée website and Journalizée no18)
- **25**th **April 2001**: She does an interview with children on the programme "A toi l'actu". (Source: <u>tinkalizée</u>) The video for "Parler tous bas" is transmitted for the first time, on the M6 channel. (Source <u>actualizée</u> (not to be confused with the magazine)
- **30th April 2001**: Alizée performs Moi...Lolita in Amsterdam at the festival celebrated on Koningnnedag (Queens day). (Source: <u>nidalizée</u> & <u>tinkalizée</u>)

- 58 **1**st **May 2001**: Alizée is interviewed on TMF, Holland by the interviewer Daphne Bunskoek. (Source <u>tinkalizée</u>)
- 59 4th May 2001: Alizée performs in Drôles de Peitits Champion (Source <u>nidalizée</u> & <u>tinkalizée</u>) (Some people say this was actually 4th of March, but Homer feels that 4th of May is the correct date. The majority opinion is that the correct date is 4th of May and in addition they say she sang "parler tout bas" and it is difficult to believe she would sing this 2 months prior to it being released as a single.
- 60 **22nd May 2001**: performance on Vivemant Dimanche is recorded in Paris; it will be shown on the 27th May (Source Diary of Alizée).
- 61 **23rd May 2001**: Interview on "Megamix Partie Spéciale Alizée" on Club RTL (Source: tinkalizée) (See 27th December 2000)
- 62 **24**th **March 2001**: Recording of Star a Domicile in Paris that will be shown 1st of June (Source Diary of Alizée)
- 63 **27th May 2001**: Alizée performs on "Vivement Dimanche" singing "Parler tout bas". (Source nidalizée & tinkalizée)
- 64 **29**th **May 2001**: Interview on "Exclusif". (Source <u>tinkalizée</u>) Between Alizée video's there are many exclusive interviews. With so many differing dates It is necessary to verify them all.
- 65 31st May 2001: Mylène Farmer and Laurent Boutonnat jointly receive the Vincent Scotto Prize which is granted by SACEM (Société des auteurs et compositeurs) (The Society for authors and composers) for the best song; Moi...Lolita. (<u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u>, <u>Journalizée</u> no20, nidalizée). Also records performance on le grand hit, this will be shown on 12th July. (Source: Diary of Alizée)
- 66 1st June 2001: Appearance on Star à Domicile Surprising Julia. (Source: nidalizée and tinkalizée). On that same day she travels to Moscow to do promotional work and she returns on the 4th of June (althought her appearances, encounters with the press, Hit FM awards where she sang Moi...Lolita and "L'alizé and an interview with Russian MTV is shown after she has left Russia. (Source Diary of Russia)
- 67 **2nd June 2001**: News Article on "Plus vite que la musique (Les découvertes de l'année)". However this is only seconds long and comments on music sales. (Source <u>tinkalizée</u>) On this day there is also an repeat of "Fan De" (boat interview) from Sepember 2000 (Source <u>tinkalizée</u>)
- 68 8th June 2001: Briefly appears in the Programme "News Block Weekly" on Russian MTV. In Russia the song "Moi...Lolita" receives the award "Hit FM award" although the exact day this was done is unknown but it was between the 1st -4th of June (see 1st June). (Sources Journalizée no20 (although wrong date), nidalizée and tinkalizée)
- 69 9th June 2001: News article on "Plus vite que la Musique (Filles à Scandale)" (Source tinkalizée).
- 70 **21**st **June 2001**: Appears on "Tapis Rouge: Spécial fête de la Musique" performing "Parler Tout Bas". (Sources <u>brin d'Alizée</u>, and <u>tinkalizée</u>) Also does an Interview in "Fun TV (Spécial Alizée)" with Lucas (Source <u>tinkalizée</u>) and possibly another one on channel MCM (Source <u>tinkalizée</u>). Need to verify if these are the same ones.
- 71 3rd July 2001: Alizée travels to Paris to make the music for Gourmandises. (Source Diary of Alizée)
- 72 4th July 2001: Sings "Parler tout pas" on the programme "Tapis Rouge Enfants de la terre" (Source Nidalizée although it has to be verified as some sites such as tinkalizée put

- this as 7th April)
- 73 6th July 2001: Performance of "Parler tout Bas" on "Graines de Stars/Bébé stars". In the programme she states that she is thinking of releasing a second album. (Source <u>un brind'alizée</u> and <u>Nidalizée</u>)
- **7th July 2001**: Repeat of Alizée performance on "hit machine" on 2nd December 2000, where she sang "L'Alizé" (Source <u>tinkalizée</u>)
- **10**th **July 2001**: The video for "Gourmandises" is shot, and Christophe Pollock does a photo session. On the same day Alizée gives an interview with the Israeli media via a telephone that will be printed in the following days (Source Diary of Alizée)
- **12th July 2001**: Alizée appears on "Le Grand Hit" on M6 channel and sings "Il jouait du piano debut". For Homer this is one of the better interpretations of the song and is precious. She also Sings "Parler tout bas". She also does an interview/game with the shows presenters Charly and Lulu. (Sources: <u>un brin d'Alizée</u>, <u>Journalizée 1</u> and <u>Nidalizée</u>)
- **19**th **July 2001**: Alizée sings "Parler tout bas" on "Plein Soleil". At first the official website said this performance would appear on the 5th of July but in the end it was the 19th of July. (source <u>Nid d'Alizée</u> & <u>Nidalizée</u>)
- **22nd July 2001**: Appears on "Génies en Herbe" singing "Parler tout bas". (Source Nidalizée)
- **25th July 2001**: The video for "Gourmandises" is broadcasted on the M6 channel for the first time.
- **10**th **August 2001**: Travels to Germany to promote the Single "Moi...Lolita" and she has a photo session with Frank Lothar Lange to promote the single in Germany. She returns to Ajaccio on the 12th. (Source Diary of Alizée)
- **14**th **August 2001**: "Gourmandises" released in France, Switzerland and Belgium. The video has already been broadcasted for two weeks now. (Source: <u>un Brin d'Alizée</u> and tinkalizée)
- **14th August 2001**: Photo Session with Phillipe Bouley for the promotion of "Gourmandises"
- **18th August 2001**: Appears on "Hit Machine" singing "Gourmandises". This date is quite possibly wrong and the performance could actually be the 22nd September 2001.
- **August 2001**: Does an interview for the "presse Jeune" which is recorded exclusively in Ajaccio and there is an interview and photo session for the magazine "Télé 7 Jours" (Source: Diary of Alizée)
- **3rd September 2001**: Interview on the programme "Exclusif" on channel TF1. In some videos the date is the 12th September, but it is in fact the 3rd of September. On the 4th of September 2001 the website "<u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u>" released photos of it stating it was yesterday. In the first <u>Jornalizée</u> newsletter the 3rd of September is spoken, however the 2nd <u>Jornalizée</u> newsletter spoke of Monday the 8th, however this is a major error as the Monday was the 3rd and not the 8th. In addition the 2nd newsletter was dated the 8th-14th of September 2001 and it would be impossible that it was broadcasted on the 8th.
- 86 8th September 2001: This day there is a performance on "40 ans de tubes" is recorded and will be broadcasted on the 26th October 2001. (Source: Journalizée)
- 87 9th-14th September 2001: It seems that Alizée was doing promotions in Japan. But this information is not safe. (Source <u>Journalizée</u>)
- 88 15th September 2001: Appeared on "Fan de" on channel M6 at 11:50 hours performing

- "Gourmandises". (Source <u>un brin d'Alizée</u>). Also appears on "Rire de Plasir" singing "Gourmandises". This is the first time she wears the famous miam-miam suit. (Source <u>un brin d'alizée</u>, <u>Journalizée</u> and <u>nidalizée</u>. In <u>Journalizée</u> newsletter a small news article is discussed that appeared on Fan2 about Alizée. It states that if you add up her sales of albums and singles she sells 350 discs and hour!
- 89 **20**th **September 2001**: Performance on "The Dome" (Germany) singing "Moi…Lolita". (Source Nidalizée & tinkalizée)Some websites call it "the Dome 20" because it was the 20th anniversary of the festival, likewise when Alizée appeared on it in 2002 it was called "the Dome 21"
- 90 **21st September 2001**: Possible appearance singing "Moi...Lolita on "German RTL" (to verify)
- 91 **22nd September 2001**: Sings "Gourmandises" on "Hit Machine" (Source <u>un brind'Alizée</u>, <u>Journalizée</u> and <u>Nidalizée</u>)
- 92 5th October 2001: She performs "Gourmandises" on "Graines De Stars" Channel M6 and is also interviewed later; 20:50 hours. (Sources: un brin d'Alizée, Journalizée and Nidalizée)
- 93 12th October 2001: Interview on "Fan club Spéciale Alizée" on Club RTL.
- 94 13th October 2001: Alizée signs a contract with Panini, who make a sticker book called "Alizée, son jardin secret (Alizée her secret garden). There are 50 photocards of Alizée that are needed to be collected to complete the album. (Source Journalizée No7)
- 95 **16th October 2001**: Performance on the Polish show "Kawa czy Herbata (café o te)" (Source <u>Nidalizée</u> and <u>tinkalizée</u>) This is the only televised performance in Poland. There was another recording for Polish TV however this was never broadcasted. In the 2nd one Alizée is upset by the interviewer and Oliver (her manager) finishes the interview.
- 96 20th October 2001: She sings "Moi...Lolita" on the German "Top of the Pops" on RTL, to be broadcasted on the 27th and 29th of October 2001. In this performance instead of wearing the normal clothes she wears Cattle tenders and a shirt. (Source Nidalizée and tinkalizée). Attention: There are 3 different performances of "moi...Lolita". This one on the 20th, 27th and 29th of October. All three are different ones videos. On "Prima Donna" on Channel France2 a performance by Alizée singing "Gourmandises" is shown. (Source un brin d'Alizée, Journalizée No7 & Nidalizée) Sophie Davant and Patrick Sebastian present the show. She appears dressed in her usual Miam-Miam dress and Sebastian thanks Alizée with "Bravo Alizé tu es trés gentile" (Cheers Alizée you are very nice)
- 97 **21**st October 2001: Sings "Gourmandises" on "Vivement Demanche". (Sources <u>un brind'Alizée</u>, <u>Journalizée No7</u> & <u>Nidalizée</u>
- 98 **25th October 2001**: Sings "Moi…Lolita" on programme "viva interaktiv" in Germany. (Sources <u>Nidalizée</u> & <u>tinkalizée</u>).
- 99 **26th October 2001**: She sings "Moi...Lolita" and "Gourmandises" on "40 ans de tubes" (or "tubes d'un jours, tubes de toujours) on TF1 at 20:50 hours. (Sources <u>un brin d'Alizée</u>, <u>Journalizée No7</u>, <u>nidalizée</u> and <u>Nidalizée</u>. The show is presented by Flavie Flament. The presenter announces Alizée with "Savez-vous comment s'écrit Lolita?" "Hello Helli T'es A" "Voici Alizée!" (Do you know how you write Alizée? L.O.L.I.T.A. Here is Alizée). Here she sings "moi...Lolita" in her usual clothes. In addition they ask her what song she would like to sing and she responds with "Foule Sentimentale by Alain Souchon.
- 10027th October 2001: Alizée sings "Moi Lolita" on "Top of the Pops" on channel RTL.

- (Source <u>Nidalizée</u>) Attention this is the second of the 3 performances mentioned above in the Entry for the 20th October. On this day it is also shown on BNN for Holland and possibly England (Source <u>Nidalizée</u>). Nevertheless the Dutch BNN performance is the same performance as the performance on RTL on 27th October, despite some websites such as <u>Tinkalizée</u> claiming that it is not.
- 101Near 27th October 2001: The exact date is unknown, but around this time, there was a photo session by the English Photographer Clive Arrowsmith. Alizée appears with a fabric-covered armchair in front of a chipped wall.
- 102**29**th October 2001: Alizée sings "Moi…Lolita on "Top of the Pops" on RTL in Germany. (Sources <u>Nidalizée</u> and <u>Tinkalizée</u>) Attention: this is third of the performances mentioned above
- 103October 2001: In the "2nd Annual DMX music awards" in United States she wins an award; "best song never released in the United States" for the international success of "Moi...Lolita". - 1056th November 2001: She sings "L'Alizé" at the TMF awards. There she receives a double platinum disc for "Moi...Lolita", Gold disc for "L'Alizé" and a Platinum disc for the album "Gourmandises. (Source <u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u>, although the page <u>here</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u> gives the date of 27th October. <u>Journalizée No 20</u> states this was in November and <u>Journalizée No 12</u> and <u>Journalizée 18</u> are more specific, specifying the 6th.
- 1066th November 2001: Appearance on the Belgium programme "belga Guiness". Still to be verified whether it is this date or the 27th October.
- 107November 2001: Appearance on "Top of the Pops" (Holland, BNN) singing "Moi...Lolita"
- 108November 2001: She appears in a clip "Les chanson des restos dur Coeur" which is like a prologue for her participation in the 2002 "Les Enfoirés". (Source: un brin d'Alizée)
- 1097th December 2001: Sings "Gourmandises" on "Téléthon" on channel France 2 at 20:50 hours. (some videos put this date as 29th October, but this is clearly an error, the date is definitely 7th December 2001. (Source <u>un brin d'Alizée</u>, <u>Journalizée no 13</u> and <u>Nidalizée</u>). Around 22:30 hours Patrice Laffont announces "Even though it is late I am sure there are many of you still sitting in front of your televisions and I am sure that a number of you like Alizée.
- 1108th December 2001: "Moi...Lolita" begins to be played on Spanish radios. (Source Journalizée No15)
- 11125th December 2001: Alizée sings "Gourmandises" wearing her Mia-Miam dress on the programme "Petits anges d'un soir" (o "Petits anges de Nöel") at 20:50 hours (according to <u>Journalizée no 12</u>) or 2250 (according to <u>Journalizée No 16</u>). Once again she receives the prize "Trophée des Anges" just like last year. (Source <u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u>, <u>Journalizée No 18</u>, <u>Journalizée No 20</u>, <u>Nidalizée</u> and <u>Nidalizée</u>. The show is hosted Veronica Loubry and Alizée talks to her after her performance in her miam-miam dress. This Christmas there is also a miniclip of her wishing a Merry Christmas. The clip is about a second long with her concisely say "Joyeux Nöel."

- 1129th January 2002: Interviewed on "M6 Kid" on M6 channel at 13:35 hours. (Sources: un Brin d'Alizée, Journalizée No 17 & Journalizée No 19)
- 11312 to 17th January 2002: Interview on the programme "Faut que ca saute" on channel J. (Source <u>Journalizée No 19</u>) Hardly anyone knows of this interview so of course there is no video.
- 11415th January 2002: An interview with Alizée appears on NRJ music awards website. Which Alizée was nominated for an award. (Source un brin d'Alizée)
- 11518th January 2002: Interview on "Fanclub" however this doubtful and needs to be verified.
- 11619th January 2002: The NRJ Music awards 2002 in Cannes. Anthony Kavanagh hosts the ceremony. (Source <u>Journalizée No 19</u> & <u>Nidalizée</u>). Alizée Nominated for "Artiste Féminine Francophone" but Myléne Farmer wins the award. At one stage in the festival she gives one of the prizes with Marc Lavoine. For the media build up she appears with a black T shirt with the words "J'adore Dior". Homer places this information in chronology as he is asked so many times about the origin of the photo. (Done the night before) There is an interview that was given for the occasion (interview NRJ)
- 11723rd January 2002: interview on "exclusif"
- 118**27**th **January 2002**: A small news article of Alizée is shown on "The Passengers" broadcasted on an English digital channel E4 at 23:00 hours.(Sources: <u>un brin d'Alizée</u>, <u>Alizée Fanclub Forum</u>, <u>Journalizée No 20</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u>) (for further comment see 11th Feb)
- 119**Beginning of February 2002**: Alizée embarks for a week of promotions in England, appearing in Pop factory, Big Breakfast, The Saturday Show etc (Source Diary of Alizée)
- 1202nd February 2002: Possible appearance on the Saturday Show in England on BBC 1 at 22:30 (Source Journalizée No 22)
- 1213rd February 2002: Small news article of 5 minutes length on programme "Popworld" broadcasted on Channel 4 in England. (Source <u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u>, <u>Journalizée No 20</u>, <u>Nidalizée</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u>)<u>Journalizée No 22</u> also states that Alizée was "pop Factory" on BBC Wales at 18:10 hours. (for further commentary see 11th Feb.)
- 1226th February 2002: Interviewed on "Top of the Pops" in England. (Source <u>Tinkalizée</u>) (for further commentary see the 11th February)
- 1238th February 2002: Possible appearance on the programme "Pepsi Chart News" on channel 5. (Source <u>Journalizée No 22</u>) (for further commentary see 11th February)
- 12411th February 2002: "Moi...Lolita" goes on sale in England. The video for the single however was censored, and considered too provocative. It could only be broadcasted after 21:00 hours. Even then the scene where the young man asking for 200 francs was cut (Source un Brin d'Alizée & Journalizée No 20). Around this date she also appears on "The Saturday show" on BBC 1 here she appears dressed in jeans and a brown printed T-shirt, exactly the same as her performance in Germany on October 29th 2001. Homer does not know if the programme "the passengers" is true as according to the English forum the only shows she performed on was the "The Saturday Show", "Top of the Pops"and "Popworld" and do not mention "The Passengers" unlike some websites. The video of "The passengers" has now been circulating on the internet though.

- 12723rd February 2002: A Programme filmed in Spain's Cubierta De Legannés, where Alizée along with other performers performed in the famous bullring. But Homer does not know whether it took place. A news item on "Fan de", although there is little here worthy of mention it does say how successful Alizée is in England and how she is part of an elite club of French singers to enjoy some success in England. (Source: un Brind'Alizée). The CD and DVD are Les Enfoirés (2002) are also released (Journalizée No 24)
- 128**24**th **February 2002**: Alizée first performance in Spain. She sings "Moi…Lolita" on "en Club Disney" at 11:00 hours on the Spanish network Tele 5. (Source Official site & Tinkalizée).
- 129**25**th **February 2002**: In the early hours she appears on "Crónicas Marcianas" At 00:30 hours (on the night of the 24th/25th) on the Spanish network Tele 5. (Source <u>Official site</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u>). The Album "Gourmandises" is released in England. (Source <u>Un brin</u> d'Alizée)
- 1302nd March 2002: Alizée sings "Moi...Lolita" on "Música Sí" on channel TVE 1 at 11:00 hours (This is rebroadcasted on the 21st of July 2002).
- 1313rd March 2002: Performance on "Deseperado club social" on Spanish channel Antena 3 at 12:00 hours. (Source Official site)
- 1325th March 2002: Appearance in a celebration that was held at the Monaco Casino dressed in a black dress. Dressed in same/similar following day. (Source <u>un brin d'Alizée</u>) (possible conflict here with some websites stating the ceremony occurring on the 6th)
- 1336th March 2002: She performed "Moi...Lolita" at the "World Music Awards 2002". In addition she wins the award for Best French singer. A prize won on the based exclusively on number of record sales. (Source <u>un brin d'Alizée</u>, <u>Journalizée No 26</u>, <u>Nidalizée</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u>).
- 1347th March 2002: Today Alizée leaves for Germany. (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>) The M6 chain are celebrate their 15th birthday and because of this broadcast "Le Plus Grand Zaping" in which there is a news article on Laurent Boyer (presenter of "Graines De star") and there is a review of artists that were on "Graines De stars" and are now famous. Due to this Alizée is given a mention. (Source <u>Un brin D'Alizée</u>)
- 1359th March 2002: Today claimed there was interview with Alizée on "Exclusif" broadcasted on RTL but this is not safe and will have to be checked. "Moi…Lolita reached number in the charts in Spain. (Source Journalizée No 26)
- 13610th March 2002: Alizée sings "L'Alizé" on "The Dome 21" (Source <u>Journalizée No 26</u> which derived the date 9th of March from the Official site. Whilst <u>Nidalizée</u> has the 10th)
- 13711th March 2002: The album "Gourmandises" is released in Spain (although the website Un Brin d'Alizée thinks this was the 18th March) and "L'Alizé" released in Germany.
- 13820th March 2002: Appeared on the show "Spécial Garou" on TF1 and Alizée is interviewed by Flavie Flament. (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>) The date of 13th April that appears with some videos seems to be wrong. In <u>Journalizée No 28</u> it states this occurred last Wednesday (the 20th). Although this could be dubious too as it comments on

- performances that occurred later on.
- 13923rd March 2002: Appeared on "Bravo Supershow" on RTL at 16.00 hours, she sang L'Alizé. The Official site stated the performance was 13.00 hours, however this is just when the performance started. There are doubts whether this occurred today. However in Journalizée No 28 it shows that the 24th repeats its at 17:00 on RTL in Germany and 16:00 in France. Nidalizee and Tinkalizée also place the performance as today.
- 14030th March 2002: Alizée's Official site announces a performance by Alizée singing L'Alizé on Top of the Pops in Germany (RTL2) at 17:45 hours. However this still has to be verified because some say this was the 6th April.
- 14131st March 2002: The Official site announces a performance on the dome (Germany) on RTL at 16.00 hours singing L'Alizé. It must have been an error by the site or a repeat of her 10th March 2002 performance. In any case it was previous to the "Bravo Supershow" on 23rd March 2002 because Journalizée when discussing "Bravo Supershow" refers to the Dome performance.
- 1425th April 2002: "Moi...Lolita" is released in Italy (source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>). For the promotion of the single in Italy there is a photo session that becomes very popular due to the prettiness of Alizée.
- 1436th April 2002: Alizée sings "L'Alizé" on Top of the pops in Germany (source <u>Nidalizée</u> and <u>Tinkalizée</u>). (Although Homer raises doubts about the date)
- 14420th April 2002: Performance on "Top of the Pops" in Italy. (Source: <u>Nidalizée</u> and Tinkalizée).
- 14525th April 2002: Interviewed on Italian MTV, very amused. (Source <u>Tinkalizée</u>).
- 1464th May 2002: Alizée sings "Moi…Lolita" on Top of the Pops in Italy. Homer believes that she sings live in this performance. It could be a repeat of her 20th April performance even though the television logo is different.
- 1477th May 2002: "Moi...Lolita" reaches Number 1 in Italy. (Source <u>un brin d'Alizée</u> & Alizee Fanclub Deutschland)
- 14811th May 2002: Report on "Fan De-Success a l'estranger"
- 14931st May 2002: Performance by Alizée on "Costapop" was predicted to happen but Homer does not know whether it did.
- 150**??** in June 2002: Interview on German channel 2DF. (Source <u>Tinkalizée</u>). Needs to be verified (this probably ZDF) and the performance of 2nd July 2002 is discussed
- 1514th June 2002: Sings "L'Alizé" on "Top of the Pops" in Germany (Some sites and even this chronology it is said to be a performance in Great Britain. However this is clearly wrong, Alizée at this time was clearly doing promotional work in Germany and Italy as can be seen, she was not doing promotional work in England.
- 15226th June 2002: Alizée sings "Moi...Lolita" in the "Festivalbar" in Pistoia, Italy.. There are many videos where the date 25th June appears as can be seen in <u>Tinkalizée</u>. However Homer is inclined to believe it this date due to info at http://www.fracassi.net/alizee festivalbar.htm (page seems to be offline). Here she wears
 - the printed red dress that she often wars for "Moi...Lolita" performances.
- 1532nd July 2002: She appears on "Stunde des Stars" on German ZDF singing "Moi…Lolita". (Source Nidalizée & Tinkalizée)
- 1546th July 2002: Performance on "Wetten dass" singing "Moi…Lolita". There is doubt whether this was the 6th. Some videos mark the date as the 7th (For example <u>Tinkalizée</u>. Some sites even mark it down as the 5th but these are wrong. It is the 6th as confirmed by

- Alizée FanClub Deutschland and Nidalizée.
- 1559th July 2002: Alizée appears for the second time on "Festivalbar". This time it is in Taormina, Italy. (Source http://www.fracassi.net/alizee2_festivalbar.htm (page appears offline) For this performance she wears cattle tenders.
- 15621st July 2002: Replay of performance on "Música sí" where she sang "Moi Lolita" (date of original transmission 2nd March even though <u>Tinkalizée</u> stats it as a different performance this is clearly wrong and is a repeat).
- 1574th August 2002: On the official page Alizée has an interview in which she responds to some questions from Internet users.
- 15823rd August 2002: First edition of "Actualizée" is released published on a quarterly basis.(roughly!) This is entirely devoted to Alizée. (Source un brin d'Alizée)
- 15930th September 2002: After months of absence a new photo of Alizée appears in magazine "Voici" she appears alongside a strangers raising speculation of a relationship. However this stranger turns out to be Oliver her manager. The new photo gives an insight to her new look. (Source Un brin d'Alizée)
- 16028th October 2002: "Voici" announce Alizée's new disc (single predicted release 12th November and Album predicted release 25th November) faces delays due to a decision by Myléne Farmer so that it did not coincide with "star academy (The operation French Triumph)" to avoid an appearance by Alizée on the show and an interpretation of one of her songs. (Source Un brin d'Alizée)
- 16130th October 2002: A special news article on "Lolitas" appeared on MCM channel at 14:30 hours, but there is no news on Alizée, but clips of "Moi…Lolita" and "L'Alizé" are used to illustrate the Lolita phenomenon. (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 1628th December 2002: 2nd issue of "Actualizée" is released. (Source un Brin d'Alizée)
- 16322nd December 2002: The name of Alizée next single is now known to be "J'en ai marre". (Source <u>un Brin d'Alizée</u>)

- 1692nd February 2003: Alizée appears in the magazine "Super stars" (source: <u>Un brind'Alizée</u>)

- 1704th February 2003: Alizée appears in the magazines "salut" and "Vanilly" (source: <u>Un</u>brin d'Alizée)
- 1715th February 2003: The dates for Alizée concert at Paris Olympia are known. (source: <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>) She appears on the cover of a new magazine "Club Extra" and in an article in the "super" magazine. (Source: <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 172**7**th **February 2003**: Alizée appears in the magazines "candy" and Fan de". (source: <u>Un</u>brin d'Alizée)
- 1739th February 2003: Alizée appears in the magazine "Fan de" (source: <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 17410th February 2003: Alizée appears in the magazines "Super" and "Star club" (number 184). (source: Un brin d'Alizée)
- 175**15th February 2003**: Alizée appears on the cover of the "Télé" magazine. (Source: <u>Unbrin d'Alizée</u>)
- 17616th February 2003: Alizée appears in "Like Hit" magazine. (Source: <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>)

- 178**21**st **February 2003**: Alizée exclusively appeared in issue 506 of the "Gaelic" magazine with the headline "Je ne fais pas exprès d'être sexy Mi-ingénue mi-libertine, la lolita de la chanson cultive l'ambiguïté" (French for I purposely do not make out to be sexy-semi ingenious, semi liberty, the lolita of the song creates ambiguity) (Source: <u>Un brin</u> d'Alizée)

It is to be called "Mes Courants électriques" and it is already possible to pre-order it at www.amazon.fr. The first of four parts of the report on "Fan De: Histoires d'un retour attendu" is shown on the programme "Fan de" on the M6 channel. (Source: Un brin d'Alizée, although there are several videos which give the date as the 1st March, such as Tinkalizée but these are wrong) She also appears on the cover of the "Téle star" magazine. (Source: Un brin d'Alizée)
- 18025th February 2003: "J'en ai Marre" is released in Franch and enters number 5 in the charts. (Source: <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u> & <u>Nidalizée</u>) The first announcement of recordings in Japan is announced (Elise). (Source: <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>) The Famous announcement on "fan de" where Alizée breaks plates whilst saying "Parce que J'en ai marre" (Because I've had enough) is shown.
- 1811st March 2003: Alizée sings "J'en ai Marre" on "Hit Machine" on channel M6 at 10:30 hours. The first public appearance since second disc (album) has been announced. (Source: un Brin d'Alizee, Nidalizée & Tinkalizée) The second part of the four reports is shown on "Fan De: Histoires d'un retour attendu" at 11:55 hours on M6 channel. (Source un Brin d'Alizee)
- 1823rd March 2003: Performed "j'en ai marre" on "Pour Laurette" on France 3 at 20:50 hours. She gives up the diamond disc she received for "Moi...Lolita" for the cause (Source <u>un Brin d'Alizee</u>, <u>Nidalizée</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u>) "J'en ai marre" is played for the first time on Spanish radio.
- 1835th March 2003: Appeared on "Top of the Pops" on France2 at 17:55 hours.(Source <u>Un</u>

- Brin d'Alizée and <u>Tinkalizée</u> confuses things by placing the date as the 3rd May, but this wrong) Alizée appears in several magazines "Télé K7" (n° 1017), "Télé Z", "Télé Poche" y "Super Stars" (n° 25). (Source: <u>un Brin d'Alizee</u>,)
- 1848th March 2003: The third of the four part report is shown on "Fan De: Histoires d'un retour attendu" at 11:55 hours on M6 channel. (Source: <u>un Brin d'Alizee</u>) Alizée sings "J'en ai marre", does an interview and sings "moi…Lolita" on "Tubes d'un jour, tubes de toujours". This show was recorded on the 19th of February. (Source: <u>un Brin d'Alizee Nidalizée</u> and <u>Tinkalizée</u>)
- 18511th March 2003: In Japan, there are two announcements (adverts) of the Japanese cakes called "Elise" with Alizée. (Source <u>Tinkalizée</u>) A small reference to Alizée on "ca me révolte" in a news article about the Lolita generation, The music and video of "Moi Lolita" is discussed and the provoking attitude Alizée could have represented by being in the nightclub as a minor. (Source: un Brin d'Alizee)
- 18615th March 2003: The last of the four news reports is shown on "Fan De: Histoires d'un retour attendu". On "Chanson n°1" a show that tributed Singer France Gall, Alizée sings "Ella Elle L'a" and then her own song "J'en ai marre". (<u>Tinkalizée</u> calls it "Spécial-Michel Berger)(Sources: <u>Nidalizée</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u>) In advanced of her next album Contract radio get exclusive right to play "Mes Courants Electriques"

- 18818th March 2003: "Mes courants électriques" is released in France, it goes straight into the number two position. (Source un Brin d'alizée & Nidalizée)
- 18925th March 2003: Final of "Eurobest" where top singers from around Europe compete. The winner was Spanish representative "Chenoa". Alizée was a guest performer performing "Moi...Lolita" and then immediately "j'en ai marre" (Source un Brin d'alizée, Nidalizée & Tinkalizée). It was in this final that Jerémy went to support the French representative "Nolwenn Leroy."
- 19028th March 2003: "Jen ai Marre" played on Italian airwaves. The videoclip is also shown there.
- 191**29th March 2003**: Alizée appears in the magazine "Star One" (issue 13). (Source <u>un Brin d'alizée</u>) Also an interview with contract radio. Interview on "48h Spécial Alizée" This will be reshown on 29th July 2003. (This video with the dates 19th, 27th and 30th are circulating but the 29th of march is the correct one as stated in <u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u> it was tonight and supported by <u>Tinkalizée</u>)
- 1922nd April 2003: "Top of the Pops" performance singing "j'en ai marre" (Source Nidalizée)
- 193**4th April 2003**: "Alive" interview (to verify is it this date or the 7th of April "Viva Neuigkeiten")
- 1945th April 2003: The Biographical book for Alizée is published "Alizée A à Z". It came out 10 days earlier then expected (15th April). (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 1957th April 2003: "J'en ai Marre" is released in Spain (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>) and enters at number 11 in the charts.
- 1967th-11th April 2003: News Article JDM MCM. (There is a "Full version" where all the interview is shown)(According to <u>Tinkalizée</u> this was 4th to 11th of July so need to be checked).
- 1978th April 2003: Alizée is in Madrid (Spain) where she does a selection of interviews for several radio shows and TV programmes. (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u>) She

- also does small video's announcing her apperance on the shows "Excite" and "Tomatic". One of the programmes she appears on is "select" for Spanish MTV. This interview will be reshown on the 12th of April. The video of the interview is one of the most easily recognizable and she is frankly graceful throughout. The interview sees a performance from the Marx brothers. At certain times Alizée cannot hide her stupefaction and this makes the interview very likely and highly recommended to be seen. Here we also see how she does not get upset from language errors. Although to make it more political correct the single is called "mon bain de mousse" "my foam bath". (Source: Predicted in <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>). We also now know that the new single will be called "J'ai pas vingt ans". (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 20728th April 2003: "Mes courants électriques" is released in Spain.(Source <u>Un brin</u> <u>d'Alizée</u>). Performance on the "Disney club" on the "Disney Channel". ATTENTION: This was not broadcasted on the 26th of April although this was predicted. Nor on tele5 as stated on the official website. (Source <u>Nidalizée</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u>) Third edition of Actualizée goes on sale. (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 20830th April 2003: Promotional Cds "J'ai pas vingt ans" is sent to the radios. (Source <u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 2095th May 2003: Interview on the programme "No n'hi ha prou" on channel 33 which is automatically transmitted to Catalonia. Alizée comments that after the tour in France, she plans to do one in Spain, something that regrettably did not happen. She also comments that after Ajaccio FC her favourite football team is Real Madrid.
- 2106th May 2003: Alizée recording on "La Chanson n°1- Special Madonna" This will be shown on the 8th of June. (Source <u>Un Brin d; Alizée</u> & <u>Un vrin d'Alizée</u>)

- 21620th May 2003: Alizée goes to Japan to do promotion over there.
- 21721st May 2003: Video of "Jai pas vingt ans" is shown for the first time. M6 channel are the first ones to show it at 6:30 hours. (Source Un brin d'Alizée)
- 21822nd May 2003: Press conference in Japan: The conference video is shown by Excite (to confirm)
- 21923rd May 2003: Japanese performance, on the show "Waratte Iitomo" on Fuji TV. (Source Tinkalizée)
- 22024th May 2003: Predicted that Alizée would sing "J'en ai marre" on the programme "Gala sur" for channel Canal sur (Spain) at 22:00 hours (according to official page but it did not get shown) some say this performance was for the 17th of May but it never took place.
- 22131st May 2003: Appearance on the Japanese programme "Gyuru Gyuru San". Alizée appears dressed in red and you can see photos of the appearance here
- 222June 2003: Publicity of "Jen ai Marre" in Germany.
- 2231st June 2003: The interview on "Sol Música" is broadcasted in Spain.
- 2242nd June 2003: The interview/report on "Taff" is shown in Germany. (Source <u>Tinkalizée</u>)
- 2253rd June 2003: The second single from her second album; "J'ai pas vingt ans" is released in France and Belgium. (Source <u>Nidalizée</u>). Performance on "Mister France" singing "J'ai pas vingt ans" at 20:50 hours. (Source <u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u>)
- 2264th July 2003: Lucas interviews Alizée in the programme "Fun TV-1 Avec Alizée" shown at 15:20 hours.(Source <u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u>). This interview is arguably one of the best.
- 2276th June 2003: Interview on "Confidencial" in Spain". (Source Tinkalizée).
- 228**7**th **June 2003**: Performance on "Baciana Versila" which is relayed on on Rai 1 (Italian) at 20:50 hours, and she sings "J'ai pas vingt ans" on "hit machine" on channel M6 at 10:30 hours. (Source <u>Tinkalizée</u>). On this performance someone clearly shouts out "leave Bitch" and this can be heard on the intro before the guitars begin playing.

The peculiar thing with this performance is seeing the mixture of the look, the "Gourmandises" with the "miam miam" dress but with the "Mes courants électriques" long hairstyle. - 24726th July 2003: repeat of "J'ai pas vingt ans" on "Hit Machine" on the M6 channel at 10:30 hours (Source Anticapated in Un Brin d'Alizée)
- 24829th July 2003: Alizée does a fifteen-minute interview on the M6 channel. (Could be a repeated section of interview from 48 hour from end of march)
- 24930th July 2003: Two news articles on German RTL. First, "VIP De Punckt" (12:00 to 12:15 hours). Second one is on the Television newscast on RTL2 at 20:00 hours.
- 2502nd August 2003: Alizée appears on "Música Sí" on TVE 1, it is a repeat of the previous programme on the 10th of May.
- 2517th August 2003: News Article on "Tubbisimo"?
- 25214th August 2003: A version of "Mes courants électriques" is published in Korea.
- 25316th August 2003: Repeat of "J'en ai marre" on "Hit Machine" at 19:30 hours.
- 25423rd August 2003: The recording of "Star à Domicile" on TF1. After the recording of Jessicas surprise and the interview with both her and Alizée, Alizée performs "J'ai pas vingt ans". (Source <u>Tinkalizée</u>) The surprise took place on the 10th of April and the show was recorded on the 25th of June.
- 26th August 2003: First Alizée concert: It took place in the mythical Olympia, Paris, in the middle of enormous sense of expectancy and excitement. It was a great success and led to the tour being extended. The tour, which was going to last until The 4th of September, was now going to last until 17th of January 2004 going around the whole of France and finishing in the Zenith concert hall in Paris. The first review of the concert was in "Le Parisian" L'Olympia was waiting for Alizée, But last night, the first star was not the 19 year old beautiful Lolita, but her godmother Myléné Farmer. The star had to be here for the scene of the little Protégé's first steps. Her apparition on the balcony caused some movement in the crowd, everyone desperately trying to see her. There were inevitable fans screaming, "Myléne" last night, as well as young spectators. A lot of children with their parents were febrile to finally see Alizée, their favourite singer. "She's my idol", said Thaïs, 10 year old from Troyes. "I have posters of her in my room, I know all her songs and I even repeat the chorography." Valérie her mother agreed, "She always speaks of her. It doesn't bother me. Some adults reproach to Alizée for her sexy side, but I think it's a part of the show. I know that my daughter will not dress that way after the concert." It's true that Alizée might drive some adults crazy with her small white extra-short and her majorette boots.

Sitting on a big metallic shoe, which is the décor, the young girl came of her pedestal in front of an Olympia already frenzied. Then, surrounded by six musicians and two choristers, she gave life to her image, mixture of refreshing innocence and soft sensuality. A swaying walk here, a lovely smile there, a striped very short nightdress for her second appearance. There were even big fish who turned around her during "Jen ai Marre" to remind us that she has a "soft skin" in her "bubble bath". After some songs, it was clear, despite the voice sometimes being drowned in the powerful sound of the group. But in front of an audience who supports her, Alizée succeeded

- 31819th December 2003: Concert at the "Elispace" in Beauvais.
- 31920th December 2003: Concert at the "Parc des Expositions" at Reims. Alizée put contact lenses in that made her seem like she had blue eyes.
- 32021st December 2003: A rumour beings (later confirmed by events) that the aim of Alizée Disc house (record company) is to stop the pomotion of "Mes courants électrique" and its singles. (Sources: moi-mylenefarmer.com (now inactive) & Un brin d'Alizée).
- 32124th December 2003: A message appears on the official web page, which translates as "I wish you all have magnificent celebrations at the New Year. Hope to have new photos for you in the gallery. Until then, Alizée. Frankly, the message was expected to be warmer and more spirited. Therefore, the consensus was that this was the word of the Webmaster and not Alizée.
- 32227th December 2003: Interview on the programme "Lollytop" on canal J at 18:30. There are glimpses here that she has a fiancée. The response to the questions regarding her third disc (album) is evasive and this begins a host of rumours on the supposed crisis with the record label, Myléne, a possible retirement of three months e.t.c. (see December 21st). These rumours create massive debate in the Alizée forum for several months (Source Un brin d'Alizée). There was also an appearance on the programme "Disques d'Or" on the TF1 channel at 20:50 hours. Alizée sung "A contre-courant". (Source Un brin d'Alizée & Tinkalizée).
- 32331st December 2003: Performance on "Les vainqueurs de l'année", on France2 at 21:05 hours. Alizée sings a medley, singing "Jen ai marre", "Jai pas vingt ans" "A contre-courant" and "Moi...Lolita" (in this order) (Source: <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u> & Tinkalizée).
- 3243rd January 2004: Interview on "Lollytop" on Canal J at 14:45 hours. This is the second part of the interview that took place on December the 27th of last year. (Source Tinkalizée)
- 3259th January 2004: Report on "Tubissimo" on the M6 channel. (Source: <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u>)

- 32614th January 2004: Performance on the "Zapping Zone" on the Disney Channel at 16:00 hours. Alizée sings "A contre-courant" (this needs verifying). (Source Alizée love & Tinkalizée).
- 32717th January 2004: Today there was a concert in the "Zenith" at Paris. (Source Nidalizée) Which concluding what had been an exhausting tour. This concert is especially exciting, being the last one and unites many Alizée admirers from all around the globe, who had previously only been in contact via the forums. The concert is bittersweet, although not all the concerts were sold out (Homer feels this is due to the elevated number of concerts held in practically one country). It is necessary to honour the public (about 80,000) who did get to see Alizée and the fact that it was an exhausting tour in which time she only realised 2 singles.
- 32818th January 2004: The beginning of the "Traversí del Desierto", the travel through the wilderness begins for Alizée admirers who wait patiently for the third album. There has been more or less 3 years since her "break" until she started work in the studio on her 3rd album.
- 32919th January 2004: Maxi Vinyl version of "Jai pas vingt ans" is published in Germany.
- 33020th January 2004: Alizée takes a more than deserved holiday. Although it is suspended for an appearance on "Follement Gay" expected to be seen on the 30th January as well as participation in this years "Les Enfoires".
- 33123rd January 2004: Sale of the 5th edition of "Actualizé". It is the first time it is sold on the newsstands and not just exclusively to subscribers, thus it sells many more. (Source Un brin d'Alizée)
- 33224th January 2004: It is debated whether Alizée has signed a contract to do another album, and what type of album it is? (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 3331st February 2004: There is a news article "La Séduction ca commence très tôt" on the programme "E=M6 spécial seduction" on M6 at 20:50 hours. (Source <u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 3342nd February 2004: "Mes courants électriques" exits the top 150 albums.
- 3354th February 2004: Alizée interview on her website where she answers questions that has been sent to the site in previous months. (Source <u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 3369th February 2004: The magazine "Voici" brings news that Alizée plans to retire from the music industry for a period of three years. This unsurprisingly spreads alarm with Alizée fans. The article can be seen here. However in issue 853 they published a correction by universal stating that "Polydor", in any meeting never considered nor decide to suspend the career of one of the most talented French singers". (Source Journalizée No 83) However the reality is that with the long "travels trough the wilderness" (18th January) this info by universal is contradicted and "the Voici" information appears to be confirmed.
- 33713th February 2004: Report on "Hit de diaments" on M6 classifying Alizée at 29th position with "Moi...Lolita". (Source <u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u> & <u>Tinkalizée</u>)
- 33816th February 2004: "A Contre-Courant leaves the top 100 singles chart. But it reaches 100,000 sales reaching the status of silver disc. All singles/albums have reached some catergory of sales with the exception of "J'ai pas vingt ans".
- 33917th February 2004: A news article on Alizée is shown on "Duels de stars" on M6 at 17:00 hours, although it was originally predicted to be shown on the 11th. In this programme there is a duel between Alizée and Lorie. Considering the sales of the respective songs Alizée wins with "Moi…Lolita" beating Lorie's "Toute searle". (Source

Un Brin d'Alizée)

- 34022nd February 2004: It is known now that Alizée's manager, Olivier will take care of other singers like Natasha St. Pier. (Source moi-mylenefarmer.com (now inactive))
- 34123rd February 2004: The magazine "Voici" well known for its criticism of Alizée announces that Alizée married Jéremy on the 6th of November while they were in Las Vegas. The forums go into overdrive, with many fans gutted and announcing their abandonment of Alizée. The news of her marriage seem not to please almost anybody. This was due to two reasons. Firstly because of the chosen man and secondly in the way they did it, in Las Vegas. It appears there is a valid marriage certificate from the Las Vegas ceremony. This does not make it legal in France, since it must be confirmed legally in France and it is not known whether this has happened. Homer prescribes to the souveneir theory with regards to the marriage, believing that they did it as a joke and as a memory of their trip to Las Vegas.
- 3421st March 2004: "Jen ai marre" reaches number 1 in Taiwan.
- 3438th March 2004: "Mes courants électriques" goes on sale priced at 9.99 Euros and reaches number 21 in the charts for midpriced music.
- 344**15**th March 2004: "Voici" publish a rectification of the information given on 9th of February and the rupturing relationship between Alizée and Universal. Universal exercised their right to reply to the allegations by writing a note to the magazine stating that there has never been a meeting to deal with Alizée, to stop her singing and prevent her from evolving artistically.
- 34517th March 2004: Rémo Buffin (lead vocalist in Alizé) decides to demand an explanation from Alizée and Universal as the similarity in names gave rise to confusion in record stores and when establishing concerts. Alizé registered their name in 1996, 4 years before Alizée appeared on the music scene.
- 3463rd April 2004: Broadcast of the programme "101 sozies" in which famous people are imitated. Céline imitates Alizée singing "L'Alizé" and finishes in 77th position. (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 3479th April 2004: Due to the rumours that have arisen since the new year about discontent between Alizée and Universal and/or Myléne an official denial is published on the official website. Translated it states "For several months the press, have been relating and spreading rumours on Alizée. They have tried to make people think Alizée has undergone an "anticipated retirement" by the record label and their production. We want to state that these allegations are purely lies and that they are total deflection of the truth with the sole intention to harm Alizée is very well and there is no problem with the record label, with Myléne Farmer or L. Boutonnat, the producer. After four years of promotional work in France and oversees, Alizée wishes, as do all artists to dedicate some time to herself before starting work on a third album. Nothing is more legitimate and is a surprise to nobody. These deceptions have unfortunately been repeateded in supposedly more serious media, therefore reinforcing doubt that fans have about Alizée. These articles also attempted to discredit their relations with the producers. Neither Alizée, Myléne Farmer nor Laurent Boutonnat wished to make a denial in the concerned newspapers, which would have only fed the controversy. However we wanted to offer this statement to the fans of Alizée and they do not need to worry about her."
- 3481st May 2004: Issue number 6 of "Actualizée" goes on sale. (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>) 34916th May 2004: Concert for the benefit association Laurette Fugain in Lyon in the

- "Bourse du Travail".(employment agency). Alizée sings "L'Alizé. There is no video although there is an audio file, but its quality is poor. (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 35017th May 2004: Alizée sings a duet with Natasha St Peir, the song is "L'important c'est d'aimer" originally by Pascal Obispo. The programme this was on was "Pour laurette... un an après" on France3 at 20:50 hours. Alizée shows us a new style, a style that is very similar to Jéremy's style.(Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u> & <u>Petite lili mania</u>) The reaction of the majority is not favourable and this unjustly shadows what was a good interpretation of the song by Alizée.
- 35122nd May 2004: Alizée sings on the TV show "Bon Anniversaire Charles" on channel TF1 singing the song by Charles Aznavour "For me, Formidable" duetting with Jenifer, and she performed it very well. (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u> & <u>Petite lili mania</u>). The unanimous opinion in the forums is that she is dressed superbly and that she sung the song well.
- 35227th May 2004: Peculiar appearance by Alizée on the programme "Select" on MTV at 18:00 hours. The singer, Jenifer was being interviewed and responding to questions from viewers by telephone. One such viewer called Anabelle asked Jenifer if she admired Alizée. Jenifer admits she does and that in fact she knew her in person. Anabelle then asked her if she had any faults. Jenifer replied that she did not. It was then that it was known that anabelle was in fact none other than Alizée playing a joke! A likeable detail.
- 3535th June 2004: There is a minivideo made by a fan showing Alizée leaving with Jenifer from one of Jéremy's concerts. On this day also, "Channel J's" programm "Lollytop" reshow fragments of interviews with Lorie, Priscella, Nolwenn and Alizée. The Alizée interview is the one she gave on the 27th December 2003 and 3rd January 2004.
- 354**29th July (or 1st August) 2004**: Sale of the 7th issue of "Actualizée". (Source <u>Journalizée</u> No 89 & Un Brin d'Alizée)
- 3553rd September 2004: Decision is made to start presenting/displaying Jéremy's new line of clothes, which is under the label SIR SID. (Source Journalizée No 91)
- 35613th September 2004: "Amélie m'a dit" broadcasted for the first time. One of the songs from the next disc. (Source <u>Journalizée No 91</u>)
- 3574th October 2004: On sale from today is a double edition CD version that includes both "Gourmandises" and "Mes courants életriques". (Source <u>Un brin d'Alizée</u> & <u>Petite lilimania</u>)
- 3585th October 2004: The CD and DVD "Bon Anniversaire, Charles" which shows the performances from the 22nd of May, it includes amongst others the duet with Alizée and Jenifer. The proceeds from the sales go to the French National institute of cancer.
- 35911th October 2004: Videoclip of "Amélie m'a dit" is broadcasted for the first time on M6 at 17:10 hours.
- 36012th October 2004: The videoclip for "Améli m'a dit" is made available on the official website and a further update on this day announces the release of the CD and DVD of "Alizée en concert". (Source Un brin d'Alizée & Petite lili mania)
- 36116th October 2004: A news article about Alizée is shown on the programme "Plus vite que la musique". There is no further information provided, and they give the perspective that the outlook for Alizée's career is bleak.
- 36218th October 2004: CD and DVD versions of "Alizee en Concert" released today (Source Nidalizée & Petite lili mania) despite the "plan promo" stating the date as the 19th of October.

- 36321st October 2004: On the website official pages a video appears publicising the new CD and DVD. It is also announced that this publicity video will be shown from today on M6 and M6 music.
- 36422nd October 2004: Due to the release of the CD and DVD "Alizée in concert" the programme "Cent pour cent" is broadcasted on M6 at 12:00 hours and 21:00 hours. In which all videoclips held at that time were shown.
- 36527th October 2004: Issue number 8 of "Actualizée" goes on sale at kiosks (Source <u>Petite</u> <u>lili mania</u>).
- 36629th October 2004: Report on "C'est pas trop tôt" in which the article's writer states that we will not be seeing Alizée return. This according to the report is due to Alizée separating from Myléne and wished to see the Lolita image erased. (Source Petite lilimania).
- 36715th November 2004: "Voici" announces that Alizée is possibly pregnant.
- 3686th December 2004: "Voici" publish on its cover and inner pages a judicial resolution which condemned the magazine for the breach of privacy against Alizée and Jeremy that occurred when they gained information about her pregnancy on the 15th of November.
- 369**27**th **April 2005**: At 23:00 hours a special is broadcasted on the channel MCM Top, on Alizée, "Top star Spécial Alizée" in which clips of her are shown.
- 37028th April 2005: On the night of the 28th/29th April, Alizée gives birth to a baby girl.
- 37110th May 2005: On the radio station Europe 2,the speaker Maurad telephones Jéremy and Alizée takes the call. This is the first time that we have heard from Alizée in nearly a year.
- 37230th June 2005: A news article on "Tubissimmo" highlights the international success that Alizée has enjoyed, however the article presents no new information.
- 3738th August 2005: The official pages go completely black without any messages explaining why. The forums take this as a dropped curtain before the announcement of Alizée reentry into the music scene.
- 3749th August 2005: There is a slight change on the official page, it is still mainly black, but the email address e-mail@moi_alizee.com is also shown. Many fans have sent emails to this address, but they get an error message (in English). Homer has also sent one but he did not get an error message, but did neither did he receive an answer.
- 375**18**th **February 2006**: A brief appearance by Alizée on the programme "Mouloud TV" on French MTV at 20:30 hours. The appearance though is brief and is limited to the presenter making insinuations and jokes. Jéremy also appears warning the presenter that Alizée is his.
- 3763rd April 2006: A hand written letter by Alizée is published on <u>Nidalizée</u>. On it she states that she is in the recording studio and will return soon. The date of this letter is the 31st of March.
- 3777th July 2006: There is a mini report about Alizée on French network Europe 2TV, on their show "Le JT de la musique". This article is of importance due to it being the first time that Alizée's return is been spoken about on TV. (Source <u>nidalizée</u>)
- 3788th July 2006: Homer believes this will be of little importance most to people but today he completes his "Alizée, salue-nous, s'il vous plaît!", His mission to write a thousand poems about Alizée, ending a mission that has taken him more than a thousand days to achieve. He started this on October the 12th in 2003.
- 37927th February 2007: Today the CD and DVD on "En Concert" is released in Mexico due

- to the increasing popularity of Alizée in Mexico, which is consequence of the commendable work by the Mexican fans.
- 3803rd March 2007: The programme "Classé Confidential" on the M6 channel is shown. Here they celebrate the 20th anniversary of the show and thus show their best moments. When they highlighted "Graines de star" they showed Alizée singing "Ma Priére" on 14th April 2000. (Source <u>Un Brin d'Alizée</u>)
- 3816th March 2007: In the continuations of M6 20th celebrations they showed the programme "Le Grand zapping d'M6" presented by Laurent Boyer. This was shown at 18:55 hours. In this program Alizée appears for a few seconds and she is seen recieving the French singer revelation of the year award on 17th November 2000 at the M6 awards. (Source Un Brin d'Alizée)
